Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

Residents of the Massapequa School District whose children will be attending a non-public private or parochial school during the 2022-2023 school year must complete and submit the online **2022-2023 Private/Parochial School Application for Transportation on or before April 1, 2022**. **Please note: This application process is in addition to the registration process completed at a private/ parochial school.** Failure to submit the application prior to April 1st could jeopardize a child's qualification for transportation.

The online form is located on the Massapequa School District website and accessed via the Student Registration banner found on the home page – <http://www.msd.k12.ny.us>

The eligibility for transportation guidelines are as follows:

- Mileage
 - Kindergarten - more than ½ mile
 - Grades 1 through 9 - more than 1 mile
 - Grades 10 through 12 - more than 1 ½ miles
- Transportation is not provided for a school over 15 miles from the residence.
- A separate application must be submitted for **each child** and must be submitted **every year**, even if a child is currently receiving transportation.
- **All Massapequa residents attending private/parochial schools must be registered with the Massapequa Public Schools in order to receive transportation and other services.**
 - If you have not registered your child with the Massapequa School District, please refer to the Student Registration link on the district website for assistance in completing the process.
 - If your child has had a change of address since last registered, proof of residency must be submitted. Please email the District Central Registrar at centralregistrar@msd.k12.ny.us for the appropriate paperwork.
 - The 2022-2023 Private/Parochial School Application for Transportation should only be submitted after a student has been registered and/or residency has been proven.
